SUBJECT: RESPONSE TO REQUEST FOR NRC UNDERSTANDING OF EQUIPMENT
REPLACEMENT REQUIREMENTS

Dear Mr. Keating:

By letter dated March 3, 2005, addressed to Mr. Ledyard (Tad) Marsh, you requested, as a Stone & Webster consultant to the Korean Power Engineering Company, a letter from the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) concerning the NRC's understanding of equipment replacement requirements, specifically on Codes and Standards compliance during replacement projects.

Following an internal review and assessment of the issues and questions that were posed in your letter, we find that it would be inappropriate for the NRC to specifically comment on a licensing issue that is presently before, or will come before the Korean regulator for disposition, regarding the Air Cleaning Units replacement at Kori Nuclear Plant Units 1 and 2.
