Decrease in Effectiveness

Two EALs changed, intent to clarify and simplify, technical error removed dose rate information as a classifiable condition.

 Back-up seismic system (as described in the Eplan) removed (due to loss of vendor support and aging system) without compensatory measures

Region IV Topics

Emergency Preparedness Equipment Control Issues

- Findings related to control of equipment important to emergency preparedness, especially EAL classification.
- EP related vandalism removal of batteries necessary for alert notification siren operation, destruction or removal of posted EPZ signage

- Ensure ERO has clear understanding of procedures
- Notification is from the site, not each unit
