SYNOPSIS

This investigation was initiated by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), Office of Investigations (OI), Region II (RII), on September 9, 2004, to determine if a former contract laborer, Stone and Webster Construction, Inc. (SWCI), Tennessee Valley Authority (TVA), Browns Ferry Nuclear Plant (BFN), was the subject of employment discrimination by SWCI management for reporting safety concerns.

Based on the evidence developed during this investigation, the allegation that a former contract laborer, SWCI, TVA, BFN, was the subject of employment discrimination by SWCI management for reporting safety concerns, was not substantiated.
