**Subject: Beaver Valley Power Station, Unit No. 1 and No. 2

Withdrawal of License Amendment Request Nos. 314 (Unit 1)
and 187 (Unit 2)**

On February 22, 2005, by letter L-05-022 (Reference 1), FirstEnergy Nuclear Operating Company (FENOC) submitted License Amendment Request (LAR) Nos. 314 (Unit 1) and 187 (Unit 2). These LARs requested amendments to the licenses for Beaver Valley Power Station (BVPS) Unit Nos. 1 and 2 in the form of changes to the Technical Specifications. The proposed amendments would have revised the Radiation and Accident Monitoring Technical Specification requirements applicable to post accident monitoring instrumentation.

The changes proposed in LAR 314/187 were based on WCAP-15981-NP (Non-Proprietary), Rev. 0, "Post Accident Monitoring Instrumentation Re-definition for Westinghouse NSSS Plants." The subject WCAP provides the technical justification for identifying the appropriate post accident monitoring instrumentation to be included in the Technical Specifications for Westinghouse plants. The lead plant for the Westinghouse Owners Group Post Accident Monitoring Instrumentation Re-definition program was BVPS.


The submittal of WCAP-15981-NP was made to the NRC by letter WOG-04-474, dated September 17, 2004, and the NRC review was scheduled to be completed by December 31, 2005 (Reference 2). However, due to a recently revised schedule for NRC review of WCAP-15981-NP (Reference 3), approval of LAR 314/187 would be delayed beyond the date necessary to support the issuance of the amendments associated with the BVPS Improved Standard Technical Specification (ISTS) conversion (Reference 4). Therefore, to avoid impact on the ISTS conversion schedule, FENOC is withdrawing the request for approval of LAR 314/187.
