I have numerous concerns regarding the Indian Point Power Plants. The two most significant are their location and their age.

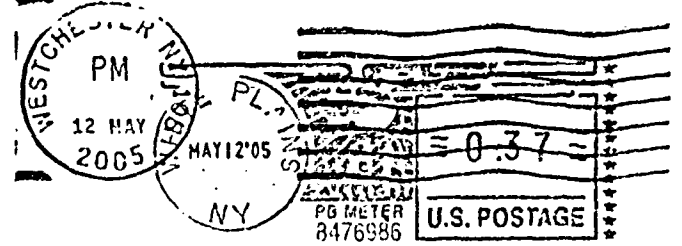
Given the population density surrounding the plants, they pose too high a risk to too many people.

We are reminded daily by unplanned shutdowns and reports of malfunctions, that these plants are far from state-of-the-art. There have been significant advances in power plant technology. No nuclear power plant with the track record of these plants should continue in operation – and certainly not for another 20 years!
