



I have not received the letter yet or the small entity form. The address to which you mailed the letter is our lockbox bank in St. Louis. Could you please fax the small entity form to 301-415-5387.

The form you need to file for termination is an NRC Form 314 "Certificate of Disposition of Materials." I cannot currently get out to the Public Web Site www.nrc.gov and do not know whether the form is easily searched and retrieved. I have a copy and could fax it to you if you have a fax number available. Let me know.

Further, since you held the license on October 1, 2004, the beginning of fiscal year 2005, you are subject to payment of the annual fees. However, since you have filed for termination between the window of October 1 and March 31, we do offer a 50% proration of invoices for which a termination request is filed during that window.

Thus, if you are approved for the small entity of \$500 based on average annual gross receipts of the entire business, not just the nuclear portion, including the revenue of any subsidiaries and affiliates (parent company), and then get the 50% proration, the amount due for half of FY 2005 will be \$250.

Absent payment being received within the next 30 days, we will refer the delinquent debt to the U. S. Department of the Treasury for collection, administrative offset, tax refund offset, credit bureau reporting, etc. Their fees can be as much as 35% on top of the NRC

debt. Thus, it would be best to get the payment made to NRC in a timely manner.
