By letter dated March 29, 2005 (Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) Accession No. ML050950587), the Commission issued Amendment No. 194 to Facility Operating License No. NPF-10 and Amendment No. 185 to Facility Operating License No. NPF-15 for San Onofre Nuclear Generating Station, Units 2 and 3, respectively. The amendments revise the Technical Specifications (TSs) by eliminating the requirements associated with hydrogen monitors and were in response to your application dated December 10, 2004 (ADAMS Accession No. ML043510203).
