Dear Ms. Campbell:

This is in reference to your application dated December 21, 2004 requesting to renew Nuclear Regulatory Commission License No. 37-30062-01. In order to continue our review, we need the following additional information:

Identify all the sealed sources you wish to possess by radioisotope, manufacturer, model number and the maximum amount of licensed material in the source. 10 CFR 30.32 (g) states that an application for a specific license to use byproduct material in the form of a sealed source must either identify the source by manufacturer and model number as registered with the NRC under 32.210 or contain the information identified in 32.210. NUREG-1556 Volume 12, section 8.5.1, also states an applicant must confirm that each sealed source or device is registered as an approved sealed source or device by the NRC or an Agreement State and that the activity per source and maximum activity in each device will not exceed the maximum activity listed on the approved certificate of registration issued by the NRC or an Agreement State. Please provide the radionuclide, manufacturer and model number for each sealed source you plan to possess.
