Your name and demographic information will be included in a Directory published by The American Board of Medical Specialties. It is your responsibility to notify other local and state or national organizations if appropriate.

The American Board of Radiology began issuing ten-year time-limited certificates in Diagnostic Radiologic Physics in June 2002. The American Board of Medical Specialties (ABMS) and all of the 24 member boards have developed programs for Maintenance of Certification (MOC). The ABR MOC Program (ABR-MOCP) is designed to assist each diplomate with a ten-year time-limited certificate in fulfilling the requirements as defined by the ABR and ABMS for maintaining certification. The concept of continuous improvement is a significant principle that underpins the ABR-MOCP.

Through issuance of your certificate, you are automatically considered in the ABR-MOCP, however, it is your responsibility to initiate the program. An enrollment application will be made available to you in 2004 and you are urged to initiate ABR-MOCP as an active participant. We will keep you informed about the ABR-MOCP via various communications. The ABR website (www.theabr.org) will be expanded in 2004 to provide updated information regarding the ABR-MOCP and to allow diplomates to monitor the status of their MOC progress. You are encouraged to use the website in the future to compile your MOC documentation.
