Regulatory Affairs Organization Changes

Responsibilities associated with the management of Part 21 determinations, identification of proprietary information, the preparation of affidavits, the submittal of topical reports, responses to RAIs, and the statement of Company positions on policy issues, rulemaking, and regulatory interpretations will be developed by and issued from the regulatory affairs office.
