ORDER

(Granting Joint Motion For Second Extension Of Time To Conduct Settlement Negotiations)

On March 2, 2005, this Board granted the parties' joint motion to hold this proceeding in abeyance for 40 days, until April 11, 2005, to allow them to pursue settlement negotiations. On April 7, this Board granted the parties' joint motion for a 42-day extension of time, until May 23, 2005, to continue their settlement discussions.

On May 20, 2005, the parties submitted a joint motion seeking an additional 21-day extension of time, until June 13, 2005, to continue their settlement discussions. The parties state that this additional time "should be sufficient for them to be able to conclude their negotiations and, if the negotiations are successful, execute an agreement."

On the basis of those representations, we <u>grant</u> the motion. The schedule set forth in the April 7th order is no longer in effect, and this proceeding will be held in abeyance for an additional 21 days, until June 13, 2005, to allow the parties to conclude their settlement negotiations.

The parties shall, <u>no later than June 13, 2005</u>, submit a joint status report advising this Board of their progress in negotiating and executing a settlement agreement.
