



- Safety: Ensure protection of the public health and safety and the environment
- Security: Ensure the secure use and management of radioactive materials
- Openness: Ensure openness in our regulatory process
- Effectiveness: Ensure that NRC actions are effective, efficient, realistic, and timely
- Management: Ensure excellence in agency management to carry out the NRC strategic objectives



Examples of Baseline Inspections

• Equipment Alignment ~92 hrs/yr

• Triennial Fire Protection ~200 hrs every 3 yrs

• Operator Response ~125 hrs/yr

• Emergency Preparedness ~80 hrs/yr

• Rad Release Controls ~100 hrs every 2 yrs

• Worker Radiation Protection ~100 hrs/yr

• Corrective Action Program ~200 hrs every 2 yrs

• Corrective Action Case Reviews ~60 hrs/yr
