S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) order dated June 17, 2002, at the Paducah Gaseous Diffusion Plant, is hereby approved.

The NRC staff has reviewed the request by the United States Enrichment Corporation (USEC) to modify the controlled access boundary surrounding the Paducah Gaseous Diffusion Plant operated by USEC near Paducah, Kentucky. The NRC staff found that the proposed security changes are acceptable, and in accordance with current regulatory requirements and the NRC's June 17, 2002, ICM Order for the Paducah site.
