Dear Dr. Gupta:

In a letter dated October 20, 2004, received December 20, 2004, and a letter dated October 20, 2004, received January 26, 2005, you contacted the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission and indicated that you wished to terminate your byproduct materials license no. 21-32343-01.

The NRC staff has reviewed your final status surveys. Based on its review, the staff has concluded that all licensable radioactive material has been removed from your facilities and residual radioactive material attributable to licensed activities does not exceed current NRC criteria.

Based on these conclusions no further remediation or actions with respect to NRC regulated material is required. Your facility is suitable for unrestricted use and NRC license number 21-32343-01 is hereby terminated with the enclosed Amendment No. 02.
