Dear Mr. Nicholson:

As stated in the April 26<sup>th</sup> letter, we had several labs at the Philadelphia Plant that used <sup>63</sup>Ni electron-capture gas chromatograph detectors. We tracked and did the specified routine wipe testing of all of our detectors and logged that testing. I have reviewed the logbook, with a log sheet for each detector showing the history and wipe tests of all of the Philadelphia Plant detectors, and I can certify that we had no problems or leaks with these detectors. They were properly transferred or disposed before or when the users moved out of the Plant.
