The purpose of this modification is to increase the ceiling amount by \$147,418.95, from \$2,416,484.71, to \$2,563,903.66, to incorporate the contractor's April 1, 2005, proposal, to add new section 4.5 to the statement of work, and to provide incremental funding in the amount of \$30,000. Accordingly, the order is hereby modified as follows:

1. Optional Form 347, Block 17 (B), is revised to show a ceiling amount of "2,563,903.66".
2. Add new subparagraph 4.5 to the statement of work as follows:

"4.5 E-Authentication

The Office of the Chief Information Officer (OCIO) has determined that material covered under an ASLBP issued protective order can contain sensitive unclassified information. Material that may contain sensitive unclassified information include, but is not limited to, pre-filed exhibits, DDMS recorded video, DDMS searchable transcripts, and final transcripts. As such, users accessing protective order file material via the internet must be authenticated through the use of a digital certificate similar to that used in the Agency's Electronic Information Exchange application.

The contractor shall design an e-authentication solution for handling POF material that meets all Federal Information Technology standards, NIST standards, NRC Information Technology Management Directives, and industry best practices standards for designing web accessible applications. The contractor shall present the proposed solution for approval by the ASLBP DDMS Project Team, OCIO Infrastructure and Computer Operations Division, OCIO Program Management, Policy Development, and Analysis Division Computer Security Team and the Agency Senior Information Technology Security Officer. Upon approval of the proposed design by the DDMS Project Manager, the contractor shall develop, test, and deploy the approved design to the Enterprise DDMS. Additionally the contractor shall update all documentation related to the approved design."

3. Section 15, Consideration and Obligation - Delivery Orders (JUN 1988).

First paragraph, first sentence, is deleted in its entirety and substituted with the following:

"The total estimated amount (ceiling) for the products/services ordered, delivered, and accepted under this BPA order is \$2,563,903.66.

Second paragraph, first sentence, is deleted in its entirety and substituted with the following:

"The amount presently obligated with respect to this order is \$1,617,200."

The following is a summary of obligations, from the date of award through the date of this action:

FY2004 Obligations: \$ 84,500
FY2005 Obligations: 1,532,700

Cumulative Total of NRC Obligations: \$1,617,200

This modification obligates \$30,000 in FY 2005 funds.

All other terms and conditions of the subject contract remain the same.
