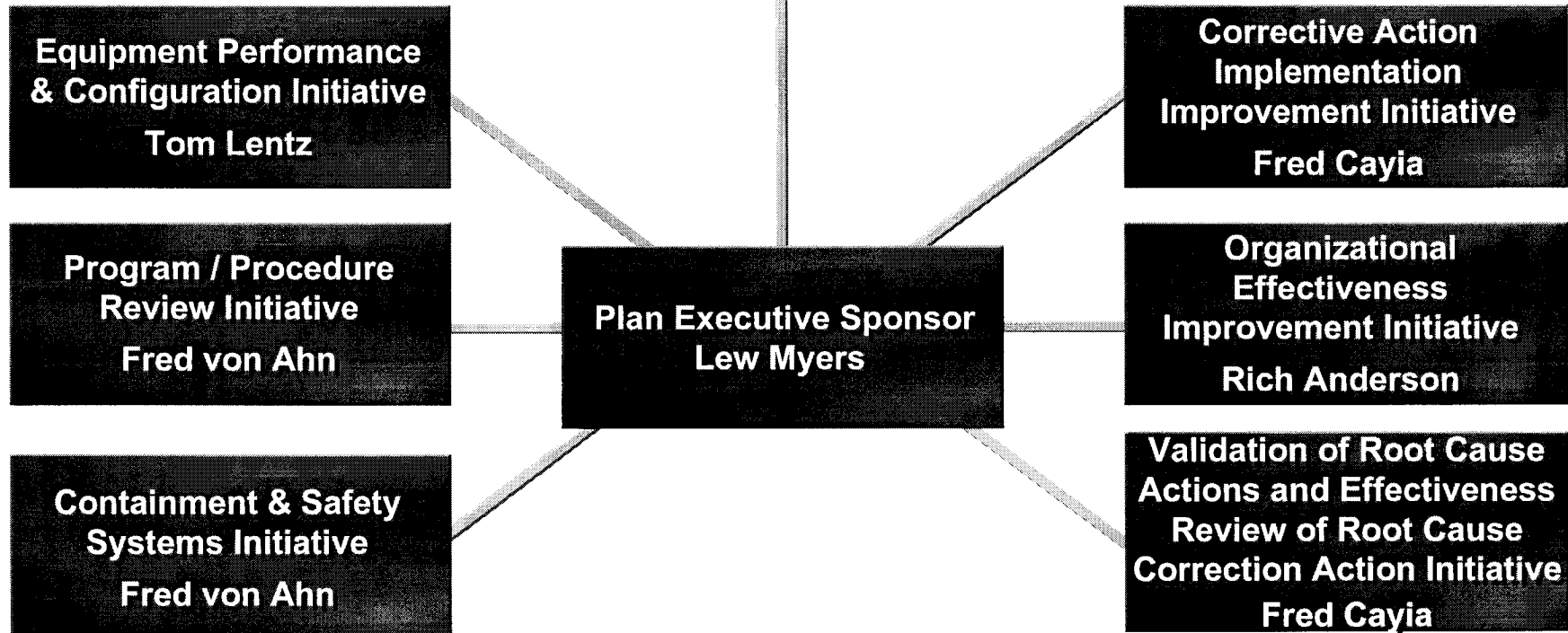

Refueling Outage Accomplished Many Equipment Improvements

- Invested time and financial resources necessary to improve plant reliability
 - Emergency Service Water Pumps
 - Digital Feedwater System
 - Emergency Diesel Generator Testable Rupture Disc
 - Fuel Reliability
 - Turbine Generator Inspection/Repair
 - Breaker Refurbishments
 - Recirculation Valve Inspection

Refueling Outage Accomplished Many Equipment Improvements

- 2389 work packages completed
- Numerous equipment issues addressed through Corrective Active Program
 - 22 Operability Determinations closed
 - 13 Temporary Modifications closed
 - 5 of the “Top Ten Equipment Reliability Issues” resolved
 - Actions resolved on 6 of 11 maintenance rule systems in A1 status

 - Safety-related calculations assessed
- Improvement Results

 - Perform additional Latent Issue Reviews
 - Upgrade safety-related calculations to Fleet standard
 - Continue long-term Fuel Reliability improvements
 - Conduct additional critical thinking & technical rigor training

 - Complete containment upgrades
 - Alternate Decay Heat Removal System installation

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Program & Procedure Review Demonstrates Improved Performance

- Improvement Results
 - Program improvement opportunities identified and actively being addressed by Corrective Action Program
 - 116 Maintenance procedures upgraded or in final approval

 - Complete remaining site program reviews and 8 procedure reviews

 - Equipment improvements driven by CAP
- Ongoing Actions
 - Ensure Corrective Actions resolve issues
 - Conduct additional CAP training
 - Continue strong oversight by the Corrective Action Review Board

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Validation of Key Corrective Actions Ensures Effectiveness

 - Validation review of selected root cause corrective actions performed by independent experts
- Improvement Results
 - Resolution of Emergency Service Water Pump coupling issues
 - Identified additional actions for safety system venting

 - Validate Latent Issues Review for Emergency Closed Cooling
