Attached is the amended Grand Gulf Nuclear Station (GGNS) Fitness for Duty Program Performance Six-Month Report. This report is being submitted to replace our previously report dated February 3, 2005, sent via letter number GNRO-2005/00004. Subsequent to the submittal of the February report, we discovered a positive pre-access test for an illegal substance was not included in the statistical data. The individual associated with the positive test was denied unescorted access based on an access authorization element on the same day the pre-access specimen was collected. The subsequent denial for the positive pre-access test occurred the next week. An administrative oversight related to data entry in the internal database that tracks access authorization and fitness for duty data resulted in the statistical data error.

Fitness for Duty Program Six Month Performance Report July – December 2004

PROGRAM SUMMARY:

The Grand Gulf Nuclear Station annual random testing rate is 50 percent. During this reporting period, approximately 27 percent of the population has been randomly tested. The rate of positive tests from random testing is 0 percent. The total random percentage for the year is 55 percent.

POSITIVE RESULTS:

Two Pre-Access urine samples confirmed positive during this reporting period. The samples confirmed positive for cannabinoid. In addition, one individual (Pre-Access) tested positive for alcohol based on breath testing.

MANAGEMENT ACTIONS:

Unescorted Access was not granted to the individual's that tested positive during Pre-Access testing. In each case where individuals tested positive, management was notified and the individual's files were annotated to reflect the positive results.

No for cause testing was conducted during this report period. In addition, there were no individuals in the follow-up testing process during this reporting period.

EVENTS REPORTED TO THE NRC:

During this reporting period, there were no violations of the fitness for duty program that were reportable.

PROGRAM EVALUATION:

No programmatic problems were identified during this reporting period. A multi-site audit was conducted during this reporting period.
