As requested, this letter provides an update on the status of the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission's (NRC's) review of the application you submitted (XR170, Docket Number 11005552) for a license to export five (5) complete reactor coolant pump systems including related equipment and spare parts to the Qinshan Phase 2 Nuclear Power Plant, Units 1 - 4 in the People's Republic of China.

In accordance with established procedure, and as indicated in our April 6, 2005, letter to you, NRC forwarded this export license application to the Executive Branch for review. A copy of the application was made available to the public and its receipt was noticed in the Federal Register on April 26, 2005. To date, NRC has received no questions on, or objections to approving this export license. NRC will be in a position to complete its review and issue the license upon receipt of favorable Executive Branch views including the required assurances from the Government of China.
