

Dear Sirs:

As Acting Director of the US Army Test, Measurement, and Diagnostic Equipment Activity (USATA), License Number 01-00126-16, Docket Number 030-12630, I exercise express authority and responsibility to request from the Department of the Army funds for decommissioning activities associated with operations authorized by this US Nuclear Regulatory Commission Material License. This authority is established by AMCOM Regulation 1-37, Delegation No 25-73. Within this authority, I intend to request funds from the Department of Army when necessary in an amount up to \$1,125,000 to decommission facilities associated with this license. I intend to request these funds sufficiently in advance of decommissioning to prevent delay of required activities.

A copy of Delegation Number 25-73, May 6, 2004, is attached as evidence that I am authorized to represent the USATA in this transaction.

SUBJECT: Delegation of Signature Authority

1. **SOURCE OF AUTHORITY.** In accordance with chapter 6 of AR 25-50, *Preparing and Managing Correspondence*, commanders and heads of organizations may delegate, to specific individuals, signature authority for certain command correspondence.

2. **DELEGATE.** I hereby delegate to Mr. Bruce Coulter, Acting Director, Test, Measurement, and Diagnostic Equipment Activity (TMDE), the authority to sign the following correspondence relating to the TMDE: formal memorandums (prepared on AMCOM letterhead); e-mail messages going outside the command; and internal, nonroutine correspondence containing policy matters, command decisions, official recommendations, or tasking actions.

3. **LIMITATIONS AND RESTRICTIONS.**

a. As Commander of AMCOM, I retain the authority to cancel or withdraw this delegation of authority at any time. Upon a change of command, this delegation is subject to review by a new commander, who may choose to cancel or change this delegation. In the event of the retirement, change of duties, or change of position of the person delegated this authority, the authority will automatically be canceled.

b. This delegation may be redelegated only in accordance with paragraph 5e of this regulation.

c. In accordance with paragraph 5d(1) of this regulation, this delegation of authority does not apply to the following, for which I retain signature authority:

(1) Taking actions under delegations granted exclusively to me, as the Commanding General, by law, directive, orders, or other media from higher authority.

(2) Stating command policy for the first time.

(3) Taking exception to actions of a higher headquarters or agency.

- (4) Replying to correspondence signed by any general officer.
- (5) Replying to members of Congress, state officials, and other persons of sufficient importance to merit my personal attention.
- (6) Denying an agency or other command permission to do something which has been requested of the Aviation and Missile Command over the signature of the commander or head of that command or agency.
- (7) Criticizing another agency or installation.
- (8) Submitting changes in programs to higher authority.
- (9) Acting on significant command level matters involving the timely provision of effective missile, rocket, and aviation weapon systems of the US Army.
- (10) Acting on significant command level matters directly concerned with military justice, equal opportunity, health, welfare, morale, safety, and security of all personnel.
- (11) Acting on significant command level matters involving the economical, effective operation of the entire Aviation and Missile Command.
- (12) Approving any action which requires additional resources.
- (13) Handling other matters of policy or decision which are of sufficient importance to merit my personal attention, as the Commanding General.

4. PROCEDURES. The authorized individual will ensure that a copy of all correspondence signed under this delegation of authority will be provided to the Command Group through the Office of the Secretary of the General Staff.
