
SUBJECT: Application for Amendment to U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) Byproduct Material License No. 42-19113-01



MEMORADUM FOR Radiation Safety Officer


SUBJECT: Delegation of Authority

1. You, LTC Tim R. Schley, have been appointed Radiation Safety Officer for Darnall Army Community Hospital and are responsible for ensuring the safe use of radiation. You are responsible for managing the Radiation Protection Program; identifying radiation protection problems; initiating, recommending, or providing corrective actions; verifying implementation of corrective actions; stopping unsafe activities; and ensuring compliance with regulations. You are hereby delegated the authority necessary to meet those responsibilities, including prohibiting the use of byproduct material by employees who do not meet the necessary requirements and shutting down operations where justified by radiation safety. You are required to notify management if staff do not cooperate and do not address radiation safety issues. In addition, you are free to raise issues with the Nuclear Regulatory Commission at anytime. It is estimated that you will spend 40 hours per week conducting radiation protection activities.
