SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF PUBLIC MEETING HELD TO SUPPORT THE ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW FOR THE EXELON EARLY SITE PERMIT APPLICATION (TAC NO. MC1125)

On Tuesday, April 19, 2005, members of the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff held a public meeting at the Clinton Junior High School, in Clinton, Illinois, concerning the staff's environmental review of the early site permit application submitted by the Exelon Generation Company, LLC (Exelon). The purpose of the meeting was to present the preliminary findings of NUREG-1815, "Environmental Impact Statement for an Early Site Permit (ESP) at the Exelon ESP Site: Draft Report for Comment," and provide the public with an opportunity to comment on the draft environmental impact statement (DEIS), which was issued on March 2, 2005.

Formal presentations, including the NRC's preliminary recommendation, were made by the NRC and its contractor, the Pacific Northwest National Laboratory. The staff's preliminary recommendation is that the ESP should be issued. This preliminary recommendation is based on the following: (1) the Environmental Report (ER) submitted by Exelon; (2) consultation with Federal, State, Tribal, and local agencies; (3) the staff's independent review; (4) the staff's consideration of comments received during the public scoping process; and (5) the assessments summarized in the DEIS, including the mitigation measures identified in the ER and in the environmental impact statement (EIS). In addition, in making its preliminary recommendation, the staff has concluded that there are no environmentally preferable or obviously superior sites. Finally, the staff has preliminarily concluded that the site preparation and preliminary construction activities allowed by 10 CFR 50.10(e)(1) would not result in any significant adverse environmental impact that cannot be redressed.

After the formal presentations were given by the NRC staff, members of the public were invited to provide comments. Approximately 300 people attended the meeting, based on chair occupancy¹. Attendees included members of the public, media, representatives of the NRC, representatives from public interest groups, the nuclear industry, Exelon, and State and local government officials. Comments were in support of and opposition to the ESP. Additional topics discussed included, among others, emergency preparedness and security, spent fuel storage, alternative energy sources, water use, health impacts, and radiological effluent releases.

¹Not all attendees signed in at the registration desk.

In an effort to improve communication and increase interaction with members of the public, the NRC staff conducted a open house one hour before the meeting and encouraged the public to submit comments and meeting feedback forms. The staff provided displays and brochures and met with members of the public to answer questions about the proposed Exelon ESP.
