Dear Dr. Lieberman:

This Board proposes to hold a meeting in this office on June 6 for the purpose of discussing the atomic power generating plant proposed on the lower Susquehanna River. The purpose of the meeting is to define or describe, rather than to solve the problems in connection with such a plant. In other words, we plan to avoid technical details and to confine our discussions to the hazards and safeguards.

The plant referred to is one proposed by the Philadelphia Electric Company for the Peach Bottom District of southern Pennsylvania. You are doubtless already aware of the proposal and we should like very much for you or a member of your staff to join us in our discussions on June 6. The State Health Department and a few other State agencies will be represented at the meeting. As suggested above, the discussions will be exploratory and no action will be taken to approve or disapprove the proposed plant.

Under these circumstances we hope very much you can join in our discussions on June 6. If so a more complete agenda will reach you sometime in advance of the meeting.
