Dear Doctor Price:

You are doubtless aware of the proposal of the Philadelphia Electric Company to construct an atomic energy generating plant at Peach Bottom on the Susquehanna River a few miles north of the Maryland boundary.

Interest in this proposal has prompted the Board of Natural Resources to schedule a special meeting of Maryland, Pennsylvania, and Federal officials for the purpose of discussing the proposed plant. Time, place, and general plans for the meeting are given on the preliminary agendum enclosed.

This Board has no legal authority in such matters and it is not expected that the meeting on June 6 will arrive at any conclusions or make any recommendations. The Board merely wishes to provide an opportunity for Federal and State officials to examine jointly legal and other problems connected with the construction and operation of such a plant.

Because of your knowledge and responsibilities in this field, we hope you can join in our discussions on June 6. We should particularly like your advice on items 4 and 5 of the preliminary agendum.

A more complete agendum and a roster of officials who will attend the meeting will be mailed to you at a later date. We hope you are free of other commitments on June 6.
