We have determined that your proposed technique is in accordance with the criteria contained in NUREG-0561 except for the override provision. It was the intent of the rule that the immobilization be procedurally irreversible for a period of time in order to relieve the driver/escort from the possibility of duress.

Accordingly, please modify your device to delete the capability of procedural override.
