Dear Dr. Wilbar:

By copy of a letter dated August 14, 1961 to Governor Lawrence, we informed you of the filing by Philadelphia Electric Company of Amendment No. 2 to its application for a Class 104 license for a proposed 49,000 Kw atomic power station to be located at Peach Bottom, Pennsylvania.

The technical staff of the Division of Licensing and Regulation is now preparing its analysis of the safety considerations involved with this proposed facility and the project will also be reviewed by the AEC's Advisory Committee on Reactor Safeguards at its next meeting. Both the staff analysis and the ACRS report will be made available to the public prior to a date to be set for a formal hearing to consider issuance of a construction permit for this project.
