SUBJECT: PEACH BOTTOM MEETING

On the afternoon of November 6, I talked to Karl Mason Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Health and we settled upon the date of November 20 for the Peach Bottom meeting. The meeting will be held in Room 812, Health and Welfare Building, Harrisburg, Pennsylvania, at 1:00 p.m.

Mr. Mason said he would contact William F. Montgomery, Secretary of Peach Bottom supervisors, Harry C. Busser, President and Mayor Kelley Asbury, Delta, Pennsylvania, and invite them to the meeting.

The same afternoon I also talked to Don Chadwick, PHS. I told Chadwick there was some possibility that we might be driving up to Harrisburg and if so, we would be happy to have him or his representative accompany us.

I have not yet done anything about the Baltimore Health Department, Dr. Huntingdon Williams, or the Director, Maryland Water Pollution Control Commission, Annapolis, Paul W. McKee. Nor have I done anything about the Maryland Board of Resources. It occurs to me that it might be worthwhile inviting the Baltimore and Maryland people to Germantown for a half-day meeting to be held some time after the Harrisburg meeting.
