

MOTION TO WAIVE PERIOD FOR
INITIAL DECISION TO BECOME FINAL



The Initial Decision herein, issued on February 2, 1962, provides that petitions to review said decision may be filed within twenty days after the date of issuance thereof, on or before February 23, 1962; that if no such petition is granted by the Commission or if the Commission does not direct the record to be certified to it for final decision not later than ten days after the expiration of said twenty-day period, said decision shall become final on March 5, 1962.

The parties to this proceeding, on whose behalf appearances were entered at the public hearing held on December 18, 1961, are the Applicant, the AEC Regulatory Staff and the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

The Initial Decision substantially adopts the proposed findings, conclusions, order and form of construction permit which were jointly submitted by the Applicant and the AEC Regulatory Staff, and to which no objections were expressed by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

Applicant will not file a petition for review of the Initial Decision. Counsel for Applicant is authorized to state that the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania will not file a petition for review of the Initial Decision and consents to the granting of the within motion.

Wherefore, Applicant moves that the period specified before the Initial Decision becomes final be waived, that the Initial Decision herein immediately constitute the final action of the Commission and that a construction permit in the form set forth in the Initial Decision be issued immediately.
