OF THE SAID ATOMIC ENERGY COMMISSION: THE PETITION OF LAWRENCE
W GOLDBERG, BY HIS ATTORNEY, MALCOLM W BERNOWITZ, ESQUIRE IS
AS FOLLOWS:

1. PETITIONER MADE A LIMITED APPEARANCE BEFORE THE HEARING
EXAMINER FOR THE ATOMIC ENERGY COMMISSION CONCERNING THE APPLICATION
IN THE ABOVE CAPTIONED MATTER ON DECEMBER 18, 1961 AT GERMANTOWN,
PENNSYLVANIA.

2. AT THE TIME OF SAID HEARING PETITIONER AS A MEMBER

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OF THE PUBLIC MADE A LIMITED APPEARANCE, PURSUANT TO SECTION 2.731 OF THE COMMISSIONS RULE OF PRACTICE, AND MADE A VOLUNTARY UNSWORN STATEMENT ON THE RECORD BUT OFFERED NO TESTIMONY UPON THE ISSUES INVOLVED IN THIS PROCEEDING.

3. ONE OF THE ISSUES TO BE CONSIDERED AT THE SAID HEARING WAS: "(5) WHETHER THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE REACTOR WILL BE INJURIOUS TO THE COMMON DEFENSE AND SECURITY OR TO THE HEALTH AND SAFETY OF THE PUBLIC." NO TESTIMONY WAS TAKEN ON THIS ISSUE.

4. PETITIONER DESIRES TO PRESENT TESTIMONY ON THIS ISSUE, AS WELL AS CERTAIN CONSTITUTIONAL QUESTIONS ARISING IN CONNECTION WITH THE ISSUANCE OF A CONSTRUCTION PERMIT IN THE ABOVE MATTER, AND BELIEVES AND THEREFORE AVERS THAT OTHER MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC MAY WISH TO APPEAR AND BE HEARD ON THIS ISSUE AND ON THE CONSTITUTIONAL QUESTIONS INVOLVED.

5. PETITIONER ASKS LEAVE TO INTERVENE IN THE ABOVE PROCEEDINGS AS A MEMBER OF THE PUBLIC AFFECTED BY THE APPLICATION

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FOR A CONSTRUCTION PERMIT THEREIN.

WHEREFORE YOUR PETITIONER DESIRES THAT YOUR HONORABLE
BOARD HOLD A HEARING TO REVIEW THIS DECISION SO THAT FURTHER
TESTIMONY MAY BE PRESENTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE ABOVE PETITION.
