Pursuant to Section 2.736 of the Commission's Rules of Practice, Applicant hereby answers the Notice of Hearing and, pursuant to Section 2.740 of the Commission's Rules of Practice moves for a prehearing conference, as follows:


1. Applicant does not controvert the specification of issues set forth in said Notice of Hearing.

2. Applicant will appear at the hearing on the within matter and present evidence on the issues specified in said Notice of Hearing.

3. It is Applicant's position that:

(a) Applicant has submitted sufficient information to provide reasonable assurance that a utilization facility of the general type proposed in the application can be constructed and operated at the proposed location without undue risk to the health and safety of the public;

(b) There is reasonable assurance that the technical information omitted from and required to complete the application will be supplied;



(c) Applicant is technically qualified to design and construct the proposed facility;

(d) Pursuant to Section 50.40(b) of the Commission's Regulations, Applicant is financially qualified to design and construct the facility;

(e) The construction of the reactor will not be inimical to the common defense and security or to the health and safety of the public.

4. Applicant moves that a prehearing conference be held, pursuant to Section 2.740 of the Commission's Rules of Practice, prior to the hearing herein for agreement upon procedural and other matters such as the exchange of testimony prior to the hearing, the stipulation of exhibits and other documentary evidence and the order and method for presentation of testimony.
