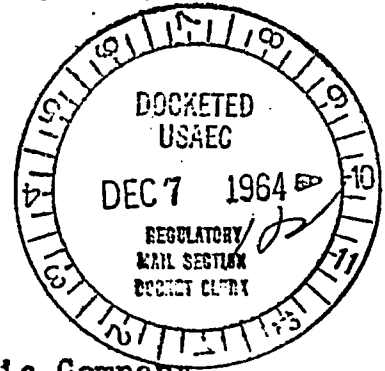

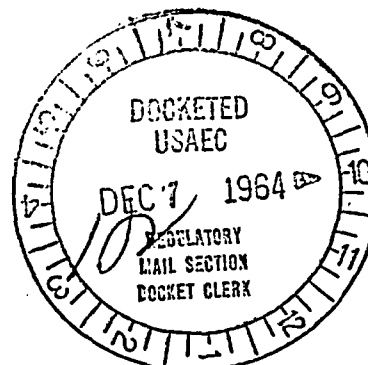
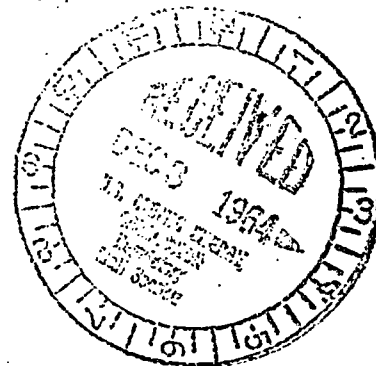

Philadelphia Electric Company hereby amends its Application in the above-entitled proceeding by adding thereto (1) Applicant's latest Annual Report, entitled "Annual Report, Philadelphia Electric Company, 1963," attached hereto as Exhibit D-1; (2) a revised Estimated Schedule of Transfers of Special Nuclear Material, attached hereto as Exhibit F-1; and (3) a revised list of the names and addresses of Applicant's Directors and principal Officers, attached hereto as Exhibit G.

Applicant hereby applies for a license to (1) receive, possess and use 250 kilograms of contained Uranium-235 and 10 grams of contained Uranium-233 as reactor fuel; (2) receive,

possess and use 1600 kilograms of Thorium-232, 4 kilograms of Uranium-234, 1.5 kilograms of Uranium-236 and 15 kilograms of Uranium-238 in fuel elements for the reactor; (3) possess such byproduct material as may be produced by operation of the reactor and (4) receive, possess and use 480 curies of Polonium-Beryllium for reactor startup sources.




