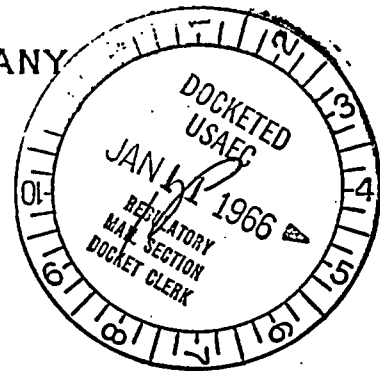

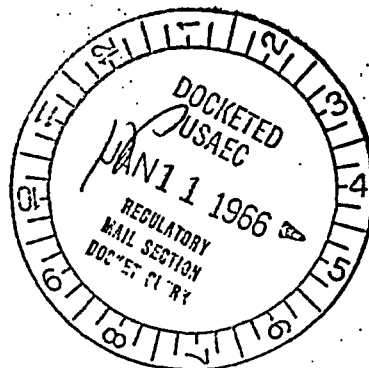

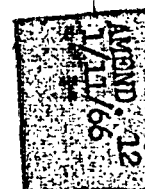

In addition to the material for which a license  
was heretofore requested in Amendments Nos. 9 and 11,

247 pounds of depleted uranium encased in stainless steel used

as a counterweight in the mechanism of the viewing device  
for observation of reactor internals and component handling operations.


