a defective element was located and removed. The graphite sleeve of this element was found to be broken, and it is currently undergoing examination in the hot cells of Gulf General Atomic.

The plant was returned to power operations on May 6, 1968, and since that date the activity of the primary system has increased to a new equilibrium value on two occasions. The extension of the expiration date of the Provisional Operating License is requested to enable a continuation of the evaluation of the fuel element performance and the higher than expected steam generator shell temperatures.




