Governor Scranton has requested me to acknowledge receipt of your letter of February 3d, enclosing a copy of the Notice of Proposed Issuance of Facility License to the Philadelphia Electric Company which has been submitted to the Office of the Federal Register for filing and publication.

We have noted that the proposed provisional operating license would authorize operation of the Peach Bottom Atomic Power Station, located in York County, Pennsylvania, at power levels up to one megawatt thermal.
