PEACH BOTTOM ATOMIC POWER PLANT - DOCKET NO. 50-171

Gene Bradley called me today concerning our prospective trip to discuss pre-operational testing that the Peach Bottom Reactor Plant ~~is~~ scheduled for Wednesday, February 10th. He asked that we postpone our trip about two weeks since they were still busy evaluating the extent of the damage caused by the fire and would not be in a position to know the extent of pre-operational retesting required until about that time.

I said this was perfectly acceptable to me and we agreed on a tentative date of February 24th for our visit, subject to later confirmation. Bradley called me again on the 9th to tell me that Peach Bottom was sending out a letter concerning the fire to the HTRDA trustees. This letter summarized the extent of the damage and added only the following new information: (a) that some 1100 cables were involved in the damage and (b) that the delay in schedule would be not less than 4 weeks. He told me informally that the schedule would probably be delayed several months.
