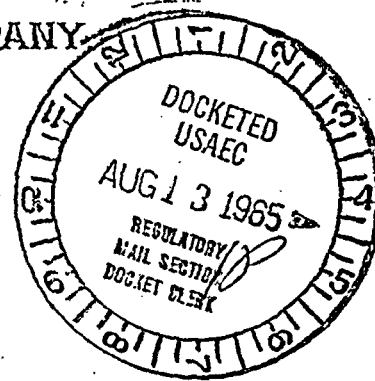

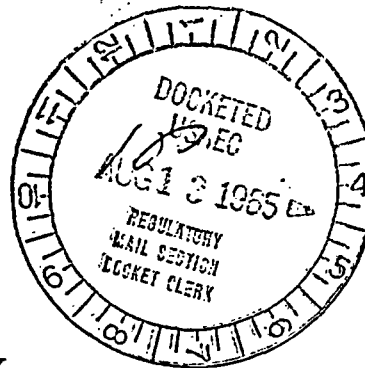

In addition to the material for which the license
was requested in Amendment No. 9 Applicant requests that
such license also authorize (1) the receipt, possession and
use in the operation of the reactor of 15 curies of Tritium
in accelerator neutron sources and 20 milligrams of U-235 in
fission counters and (2) the possession and use in the opera-
tion of the reactor of Antimony-Beryllium as photoneutron sources

(150 grams Antimony, saturation activity 10^9 n/sec/source,
7 sources).


