Dear Mr. Carlson:

Enclosed is Amendment No. 13 to your NRC Material License No. 21-26775-01 in accordance with your request. Please note that the changes made to your license are printed in **bold font**.

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand all conditions. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region III office at (630) 829-9887 so that we can provide appropriate corrections and answers. 1. This also refers to the telephone conversation between you and me on April 19, 2005, in which we discussed the requests in your letter dated February 23, 2005, to allow licensed materials to be delivered and picked up from Mirview vans without Mirview personnel being present.

I advised you that we would be unable to authorize these requests. Please refer to NUREG 1556, Vol. 9, Appendix V, pages V-2 and V-5 and the excerpts as follows:

"...Byproduct material delivered (if necessary) directly to the van only if the van is occupied by licensee personnel at the time of delivery."

And,

"...Delivery of byproduct material to a van that is not occupied by the mobile medical service personnel will not be permitted."

I hope this resolves your inquiry.

2. In correspondence received March 24, 2005, you indicated that you wished to release your former storage location for reference sources for unrestricted use. The NRC staff has reviewed your final status surveys. Based on its review, the staff has concluded that all licensable radioactive material has been removed from your former storage location and residual radioactive material attributable to licensed activities does not exceed current NRC criteria.

Based on these conclusions no further remediation or actions with respect to NRC regulated material is required for this area of use and it is suitable for unrestricted use.

3. At this time I deleted Condition No. 16., as it appeared on Amendment No. 12, because it is not appropriate or necessary for your licensed program.
4. Please note the addition of Condition No. 10.B., which clarifies the authorization you

requested to store sealed sources for equipment testing and reference at 120 Enterprise Drive, Ann Arbor, Michigan.

You will be periodically inspected by NRC. Failure to conduct your program in accordance with NRC regulations, license conditions, and representations made in your license application and supplemental correspondence with NRC will result in enforcement action against you. This could include issuance of a notice of violation, or imposition of a civil penalty, or an order suspending, modifying or revoking your license as specified in the General Statement of Policy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Actions. Since serious consequences to employees and the public can result from failure to comply with NRC requirements, prompt and vigorous enforcement action will be taken when dealing with licensees who do not achieve the necessary meticulous attention to detail and the high standard of compliance which NRC expects of its licensees.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.390 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," a copy of this letter will be available electronically in the NRC Public Document Room or from the Publicly Available Records (PARS) component of NRC's document system (ADAMS). The NRC's document system is accessible from the NRC Web site at <http://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/adams.html>. The enclosed license document is exempt from public disclosure in accordance with 10 CFR 2.390, because its disclosure to unauthorized individuals could present a security vulnerability.
