SUBJECT: PHILADELPHIA ELECTRIC COMPANY - INDEMNITY AGREEMENT NO. B-28,  
AMENDMENT NO. 1 - DOCKET NOS. 50-171 AND 70-906

This supplements my memorandum to files of December 30, 1964, same subject.

DRL is about to issue Operating License DPR-12 to the subject licensee authorizing operations at one megawatt. At that power level, financial protection in the amount of \$1,500,000 is required, and proof of existence of same has been received in Endorsement No. 7 to NF-140. Amendment No. 1 to the indemnity agreement is being prepared reflecting the increase in financial protection, the addition of the operating license and the change in the location to cover the complete facility rather than the storage only previously covered.

The indemnity fee will remain at \$100.00 per year.

Philadelphia Electric Company is in full compliance with the requirements of 10 CFR Part 140. Amendment No. 1 to the indemnity agreement will be issued concurrent with the issuance of the operating license.
