We have reviewed your Physical Security Plan for Special Nuclear Material of Low Strategic Significance, transmitted by letter dated January 7, 2005, and have determined that the changes in the Plan meet the requirements of 10 CFR 70.32(e) in that none of the changes decrease the effectiveness of the physical security program, pursuant to 10 CFR 70.67(f) and (g). Existing Safeguards Condition SG-2.1 of License SNM-1107 will be modified in a future amendment to reflect the Westinghouse Physical Security Plan - Revision 32.
