JOINT REPORT REGARDING REVIEW OF PARTIAL INITIAL DECISION  
(ENVIRONMENTAL CONTENTIONS) FOR PROPRIETARY INFORMATION


This joint report is submitted on behalf of Louisiana Energy Services, L.P. ("LES"), Nuclear Information and Resource Service and Public Citizen ("NIRS/PC"), and the NRC Staff, and responds to the directive set forth in paragraph 6.2 (pp. 83-84) of the Licensing Board's June 8, 2005 Partial Initial Decision (Environmental Contentions).<sup>1</sup> Specifically, the Board directed LES, NIRS/PC, and the Staff to submit a joint filing outlining all proposed redactions of proprietary information from the Board's decision, and indicating any objections to the proposed redactions. The aforementioned parties have reviewed the Board's decision in its entirety, and hereby notify the Board that the text of the decision itself contains no proprietary information that must be withheld from public disclosure. Therefore, the parties do not propose any redactions from the decision.

Notwithstanding, LES notes that the discussion on pages 81 to 82 of the Board's partial initial decision contains references to six LES exhibits (*i.e.*, draft and executed uranium

enrichment services contracts between LES and unidentified utilities), and to *in camera* testimony provided by LES witness Kirk Schnobelen. The cited exhibits and testimony contain information that is proprietary to LES and other commercial entities. Accordingly, the exhibits and testimony should continue to be treated as proprietary.


