SUBJECT: FRAMATOME ANP, INC. (LYNCHBURG), CORRECTION TO RENEWAL OF
LICENSE SNM-1168 (TAC L60433)

Dear Mr. Holman:

This refers to the renewal of your license dated December 12, 2003 (ADAMS No. ML033490058). By letter dated June 3, 2005, you brought to our attention that a typographical error exists in your license that began with the issuance of your renewed license. In the license renewal process, NRC approved the removal of line 6.C., 7.C., and 8.C., thereby removing a reference to natural uranium in the form of UF₆ from your license. Following the removal of line 6.C., 7.C., and 8.C., the license and references to all succeeding lines should have been updated. In particular, prior to and following license renewal, line 9 of the license was not updated. It reads as follows:

“Authorized place of use: The licensee’s existing facilities at Lynchburg, Virginia. Material identified in Condition 6.I., 7.I., and 8.I., may be used at temporary job sites throughout the United States where the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission retains jurisdiction for regulating the use of licensed materials.”

Following license renewal and as discussed previously, line 9 of the license should have reflected the deletion of line 6.C., 7.C., and 8.C., and line 9 amended to change the references to line 6.H., 7.H., and 8.H.

Accordingly, your license has been corrected to include the proper references on page 2, line 9 of your license. Please insert the corrected page 2 from the enclosed license and destroy the old page 2. Note that in addition to correcting the license, this corrected page supersedes page 2 enclosed in Amendments 1 and 2, dated March 23, 2004, and September 15, 2004, respectively.
