## Dear Major Hamilton:

This is to confirm Dennis Lawyer's telephone conversation on May 16, 2005 with you in which we discussed the information we need to continue review of your application dated April 25, 2005. The items discussed are specified below.

- 1. The Decommissioning Plan Cost Estimate of 2005 submitted with the renewal is not consistent with the March 4, 1992, Decommissioning Funding Plan. This plan must include an actual estimate of the costs for decommissioning your facility. The appropriate level of detail for the cost estimate is discussed in Appendix A.3 to NUREG-1757 Volume 3, "Consolidated NMSS Decommissioning Guidance". Please update the Decommissioning Plan with appropriate supporting documents.
- 2. The Statement of Intent submitted with the renewal did not contain the title of the person signing or the date of signature. Please resubmit the Statement of Intent indicating the title of the person signing and the document dated.
- 3. Describe the surveys you will require and the criteria you will use for release of facilities and equipment for unrestricted use. Confirm that facilities and equipment will not be released until the results of surveys are reviewed and approved by the Radiation Safety Officer.
