Thank you for the follow-up information provided during our conference call earlier today. I wanted to send you this message just to be sure we captured the significant parts of the conversation. The following items are the ones we noted:

\* Your Reviewers wanted to know if we would be submitting drawings relevant to the NSR (a)(2) re-scoping effort. Our response was that although we had not originally intended to provide such drawings with the amended Application, we will be able to send hand-marked drawings for the systems added or system were we excluded some equipment during the re-scoping effort with the LRA on July 15th. Other systems within the (a)(2) category will be hand-marked and sent as soon as practicable.

\* The text in the LRA will be expanded with respect to level of detail for the (a)(2) re-scoping effort as requested during the June 9th meeting and reiterated during today's phone call.

\* Since the exchange of letters between NMP and NRC in early March, the Staff has not generated any formal requests for additional information (RAIs); however, you requested that we confirm that we had received certain items and will respond to them. We confirmed the items mentioned had been received and responses have either been developed or are in the process; these included: RAI 4.7.2 (MSIV corrosion allowance), RAI B2.1.11-2 (U2 Control Building Chilled Water (HVK) System, and RAI 3.1.2.C.4-1 (Material specifications for NSR piping, etc.). You also mentioned the Staff had a comment that had not been forwarded to us that asked about our commitment to implement enhancements associated with the Closed-Cycle Cooling Water Program (XI.M21); we expect to address this commitment in the appropriate LRA section.

\* You requested the e-mails that contained reference to the RAIs to assure the ADAMS Accession numbers were present and correct. I sent these to you earlier today.

\* You noted that an Electrical Reviewer may have some questions regarding previous responses; however, at this time the Staff will wait for the amended LRA to see if those questions are answered satisfactorily therein.

\* We requested that you let us know the number of LRA "hard copies" and "CDs" you need for your review at your earliest convenience.

Again, thanks for taking the time to clarify these issues; if there are any discrepancies in the above summary, please let me know.
