In a letter dated May 10, 2005, Power Resources, Inc. (PRI), informed you that of recent staffing changes at the Smith Ranch-Highland Uranium Project (SR-HUP) including the appointment of Tim McCullough as Acting Radiation Safety Officer. In that letter, PRI summarized Mr. McCullough's qualifications, and since Mr. McCullough was not current on the bi-annual RSO training requirements outlined in the NRC Regulatory Guide 8.31, oversight for the radiation safety programs at SR-HUP was to be performed by Mike Griffin, Manager- Health, Safety and Environmental Affairs for Crow Butte Resources until such time that Mr. McCullough became current with the bi-annual RSO training.


