
Subject: Notification Pursuant to 10 CFR 72.212, "Conditions of general license issued under 72.210," Prior to First Storage of Spent Fuel

Pursuant to 10 CFR 72.212, paragraph (b)(1)(i), we are notifying the NRC, at least 90 days prior to the first storage of spent fuel, of our intent to begin the loading of spent fuel into a storage cask under the general license at Quad Cities Nuclear Power Station, Units 1 and 2. Loading activities are currently scheduled to commence on October 31, 2005. For the first storage of spent fuel, we will use a Holtec International, Inc. HI-STORM 100 Cask System in accordance with Certificate of Compliance No. 1014 (Amendment 2).
