SUBJECT: TERMINATION OF NRC LICENSE NO. 04-26507-01MD

By letter dated March 11, 2005, Dr. Kory Kodimer of your office contacted the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission and requested a change of address from Woodland Hills, California to Dublin, Ohio. **This request was approved and a new license and license number reflecting your location within the State of Ohio was issued on June 28, 2005.** Concurrent with the issuance of your new license (No. 34-29200-01MD) we are hereby terminating license number 04-26507-01MD.
