This letter and the enclosed NRC Form 591M refer to the inspection conducted on May 12, 2005, at the Cardinal Health facility located at Georgetown Road, Indianapolis, Indiana. The inspection results were discussed you and Mr. Paul Gotti during a final telephonic exit briefing conducted on June 30, 2005.

The inspection was an examination of activities conducted under your license as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and with the conditions of your license.
