In letter dated February 21, 2005, you indicated that Associated Metals, Inc. does not expect to handle or process radioactive material in the near future, however, before you reactivate licensed activities, please provide a facility diagram showing where material will be used and stored including adjacent areas. In addition, included with this letter is 10 CFR Part 30, please review in particular 30.36 (d) which discusses circumstances under which the license should be terminated.

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand all conditions. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region III office at (630) 829-9887 so that we can provide appropriate corrections and answers.
