3) Transportation and Route Schedule

The vessel sailed from Adelaide, Australia on January 29, 2004. The ocean transportation from Adelaide, Australia to Vancouver, British Columbia, Canada will be the responsibility of Hamburg Sud Line. The vessel will unload at Vancouver, British Columbia, Canada on February 27, 2004. The containers will then be loaded onto the rail for importation to Ranier, MN.
