I informed the licensee that they would still be authorized to perform the activities under the tie-down condition, ie., License Condition No. 27. I would, however, get back in touch with them after checking with management and the possible need to change the two conditions. 10:30 After looking over the license and speaking with management, I called Mr. Knuettel back. I explained that License Condition Nos. 21 and 23 are standard boilerplate conditions and appear the same in every license they are in. However, License Condition No. 20 refers to all of the non-routine activities for which the licensee is authorized and takes precedence
